The kit fee that you paid is for all the fabric needed to make this quilt as a standalone project or incorporate the pieces into a larger quilt in combination with the pieces you make in Charlotte Angotti's and/or Karen K Stone's class(es).

The kit is almost entirely precut. There is just a bit of cutting that you will have to do in class during the construction.

**Please bring all of the following to class.**

**Rotary cutter**

**Mat** – A 12" x 18" mat is the perfect size for class.

**Ruler** – A half-square triangle tool such as an Omnigrid 96 or 96L or Easy Angle or a small square ruler (4" - 6½") is all you need. I prefer the triangle tool for this technique, but a small square works just fine, too. There is no need to purchase a triangle tool just for this class. Bring one if you already have one.

**Basic sewing tools** – Pins, seam ripper, and any tools you like to have on hand for chain piecing.
